After years of neglect, **Divya**, '12, was adopted by a family in Santa Fe that includes Gardner (left) & Wyatt.



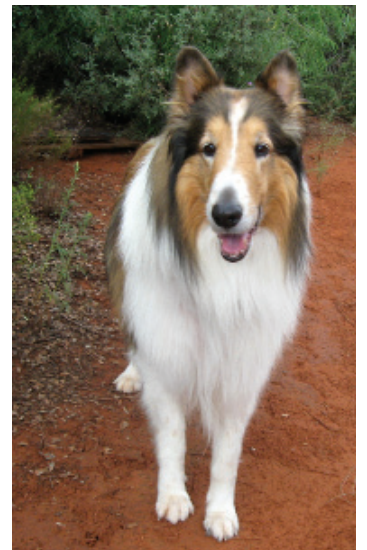
Blake, '07 & **Dolly**, '08 enjoy their yard in El Paso with Sylvia & Victor.

'**Bama**, '10, of Santa Fe (sable & white) and Cole play grab-the-toy. Little Hannah says, "Silly boys!"

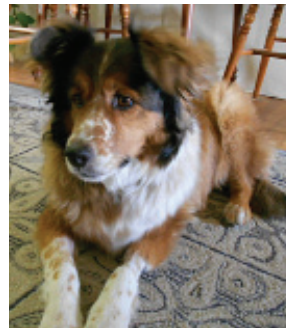


Otis, '12, fully recovered from his broken leg, is having a great life with Diane & Rick in Sedona, AZ.

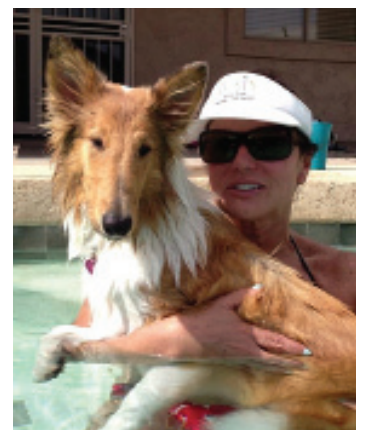
