

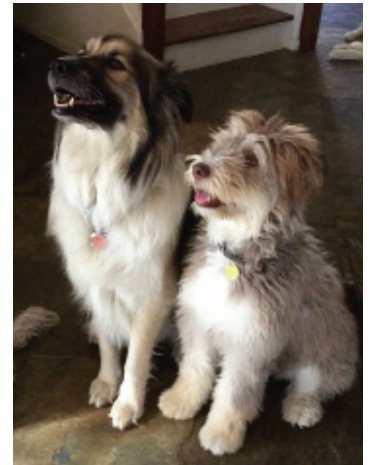
COLLIES AT HOME
